# Isolation, use of force and incidents in youth detention

#### Regulation of home education

A review of the prevalence of home education in high-risk home environments, including an analysis of the regulations of home education in Queensland.



#### **Self-placement**

Analysis of the demographics, locations, patterns and rates of self-placement by cohort including a case file read to assess how safety assessment and practice responses are having effect.



### Police discretion

A quantitative analysis of how police discretion is being applied through the Youth Justice system, for specific cohorts and locations, including a policy review to identify any practice and procedural issues.



#### **Reunification planning** and Delegated Authority

A case file read aimed at articulating the differences and strengths of the reunification work led by REFOCUS.



#### **Permanent Care Orders**

A case review of the incidences of granting Permanent Care Orders in relation to First Nations children and the apparent escalation in use of this type of order.



#### **Foster and Kinship Carer capacity**

An assessment of the turnover of carer households in Queensland compared to other jurisdictions, with analysis of the carer cohort.



#### Placement turnover, stability and self-placing

A quantitative analysis of the experience of children in out-of-home care looking at their placements, including comparison and practice changes across Australia.



#### **Prevention services** in Youth Justice

Analysis of how family support programs are assisting to prevent young people's entry into Youth Justice. Review will include an economic lens on the impact of early intervention in youth justice building on work being undertaken by 54 Reasons and Australian Child Rights Taskforce.

A life story mapping from Child Death Review Board (CDRB) files to identify common points for improved intervention for children.



#### Youth diversion program outcomes

A quantitative assessment of the recidivism rates across the community Youth justice programs.



#### Parenting in out-of-home care

A review of the incidence of children in care becoming parents, including the policy, procedures and funding support.



#### Families in the child protection system

A qualitative interview and survey process to assess how parents are experiencing Child Safety processes and how the charter of rights for parents is being upheld.



#### **Restorative Justice Conferencing**

A case file review and programmatic comparison of best practice on effective **Restorative Justice Conferencing** including the performance standards and funding model in place in Queensland.



#### **Indicators of adversity** and social vulnerability in child mortality

Defining, measuring and gathering data to build an evidence base on family-level adversity and social vulnerability and how this relates to child mortality.



#### Redefining assault and neglect

The identification of appropriate definitions, classifications and screening criteria to more confidently identify types of assault and neglect, in order to gather information and determine how information should be reported.



### Child car restraint use

A quantitative study to understand use and impact of child car restraint



#### **Exits from care**

A quantitative analysis (with case file reviews as appropriate) to determine more clearly where children exiting out-of-home care are going.



#### Preventable childhood mortality

A quantitative analysis of the rate of preventable conditions resulting in child mortality in Queensland and assessment of measures for preventable deaths.

#### **Sudden Unexpected Deaths in Infancy**

A quantitative study linking Perinatal data with the Queensland Child Death Register, to improve understanding of risk factors in sudden unexpected deaths in infancy (SUDI) by enhancing Child Death Register data with detailed health history from health records.

### **Examination Reviews**



Examination of the impact of the Cross-Government panels focused on serious repeat offenders

A quantitative and case file analysis of how the youth justice taskforce/multi-agency panels and the Serious Repeat Offender Index reporting approach has led to practice and recidivism changes and how young people and families have been impacted.



\*\*\* Family support service system efficacy

A qualitative look at the family support service system and how it supports and prevents family's holistically to prevent their entry into child protection and youth justice. This will have a specific focus on funding, social benefit bonds, the Family Wellbeing Program, and Family and Child Connect.



\*\*\* Blue Card deep dive

A forensic examination of the effectiveness of the Blue Card scheme, considering the implementation of past reforms and those recommendations that have not yet been completed.

Analysis of the policies and practice that support the recruitment and retention of kinships carers.

Cohort analysis of the children in residential care including the age, sibling group status and child protection history.



#### Intake and resubstantiation assessment

A quantitative assessment of how the child protection system is assessing risk and safety for children with a focus on how resubstantiation and renotification rates could be reduced.



#### Information sharing success

A look at the information sharing frameworks and innovations in place to keep children and families safe.

## **School reengagement**

A quantitative and case file read on how young Queenslanders (particularly those with emerging Youth Justice exposure) are reengaged into education or employment programs.

A quantitative review of Queensland's children and families across the life domains, presenting a regional focus with case studies on the lived experience of Queenslanders including with specific focus on out-of-home care and youth justice cohorts.

#### Hearing families and children

An assessment of the child protection and youth justice complaints processes, including a mapping of the oversight entities practices and policies.



#### Life outcomes for children in out-of-home care

An early look at the impact of implementing Support 21 including a quantitative assessment of post-care life domain measures (i.e. housing, employment, health, etc).



#### School achievement for children in out-of-home care

A quantitative compilation of the trends and changes in school achievement for children in care including performance, attendance and exclusion.



#### Informed young people and families

An analysis of insights from children, families and the sector about how youth justice practices and legal proceedings give practical and measured effect to the Charter of youth justice principles to inform children and families and have them participate.
